

Exam Timetable Year 11, Semester 2 2009

Students should carefully check the timetable for times they must attend their exams. All students have at least one exam to attend.

Arrangements for exams – please read the following carefully to ensure you do not disadvantage yourself

- ▶ Students are required to wear **school uniforms** during exams. Students who are not in uniform will be sent home to get changed. No extra exam time will be given in these circumstances.
- ▶ Exams will be held in the **English Block**.
- ▶ As **TEE** exams are also being held in the English Block, **silence is required at all times** during these exams and when entering and exiting the exams.
- ▶ Books, files, notes are not to be brought into the exam room unless specified.
- ▶ **Mobile phones are not permitted in the exam room.**
- ▶ Only approved calculators are to be brought into the examination room.
- ▶ Students are not permitted to eat in the examination room except for medical reasons where a medical certificate must be provided. Students are permitted to bring water provided it is in a **clear** plastic bottle with **labels removed**.
- ▶ During the reading time, no writing is allowed.
- ▶ Students requiring attention during the examinations should raise their hand to indicate this.

Sickness: You should not miss an exam if you simply do not feel well. However, you should not attend an exam against specific medical advice. If you are ill and unable to attend an exam, or if you feel illness may have affected your exam performance, you *must* inform the deputy principal and produce a medical certificate covering the time of the exam/s.
