The community of Leeming Senior High School, through its School Council, has chosen to have a designated School Uniform for the following reasons:

School Uniform

1. Enhances a sense of belonging, equality and community spirit.
2. Separates school from leisure time, focusing students' efforts on learning.
3. Prepares students for the expectations of post school employment.
4. Assists the school identify unwelcome strangers.
5. Promotes a positive image of the school by ensuring a minimum standard of presentation of all students.

School Uniform Requirements

The mix and match nature of the school uniform allows students a degree of choice in what they wear to school each day.

With the full cooperation of parents and students we can have the student body looking good and that does much to enhance the school's standing in the community as well as fostering a strong school spirit.

Uniform Shop

To support the Uniform Policy the P&C operates a Uniform Shop (within the school next to the Canteen) as a service to parents. Both new and good quality second-hand clothing items and current second-hand text books are available at the shop all year round.

Donations of clean used uniforms and current school books can be left at the uniform shop or school reception marked 'Attention Uniform Shop'.

All proceeds of sales go to the P&C and are spent throughout the school to benefit all students.
